Complex Verbs – The Suffix ‘t’: **talowʋt pisa** – try to sing

Note: When you have two verbs together, the first verb gets the ‘t’ suffix.

Talowʋt pisa sʋ bʋnna.

I want to try to sing.

ʋlla pʋt talowʋt pisa tuk.

This child tried to sing.

Word Meaning: **pʋt** (paht) = this/these

talowʋt pisa (tah-loh-waht pih-sah) = try to sing

sʋ (sah) = I **bʋnna** (bahn-nah) = want/need

ʋlla (ahl-lah) = child

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
