Aki yvt holisso chima tuk.

My father gave you a book

Skvlli chima li tuk!

I gave you money!

Nanta chima tuk?

What did he/she give you?

Word Meaning:

aki (ahn-ke) = my father

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

holisso (ho-lis-so) = book  
to you

chima (chim-ah) = to give

skvlli (skahl-le) = money

nanta (nahn-ta) = what

li (le) = I, after a verb

tuk (tuk) = past tense

he/she – unmarked subjects – understood in the context of the sentence.
