Vocabulary: **yimmi** – to believe (lesson 2)

Kvta ish i yimmi? Who do you believe?

Mak sv yimmi. That's what I believe. or

Mako sv yimmi. That's what I believe.

Word Meaning:

kvta (kah-tah) = who

ish (esh) = you

i (ehn) = to or for him/her/it

yimmi (yihm-mih) = to believe

mak (mahk) or **mako** (mah-kohn) = that

sv (sah) = I
