Possessive Pronoun: **a** - my

**A katos vt lakna.**

My cat is yellow.

**A katos vt nusi ho?**

Is my cat asleep/sleeping?

Nasalized '**a**': Shows ownership and is used before the names of items that begin with a consonant letter.

There are two forms of possessive pronouns; the –m form and the nasalized form. The –m form is prefixed before words that begin with vowels and the nasalized form is prefixed before words that begin with consonants.

**Word Meaning:** **a** (ahn) = my

**katos** (kah-tohs) = cat

**lakna** (lak-na) = yellow

**vt** (aht) = subject marker

**nusi** (noh-sih) = asleep/sleeping

**ho** (hohn) = question marker

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
