Location/Position: antta – to be temporary (singular)

Aiittvtoba antta li.

I am at the store.

Im aboha antta.

She is in her room.

Word Meaning:

aiittvtoba (eye-iht-tah-toh-bah) = store

antta (ahnt-tah) = to be temporary (singular)

li (lih) = I

im (ehm) = his, her, it – possessive pronoun

aboha (ah-boh-ha) = room
