Opposites: kapussa – cold and lashpa – hot

Kvfi yvt lashpa.

The coffee is hot.

Oka kapussa ishko sv bunna.

I want a drink of cold water.

Word Meaning: **kvfi** (kah-fe) = coffee

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **lashpa** (lahsh-pa) = hot

oka (oh-kah) = water **kapussa** (kah-pas-sah) = cold

ishko (ish-koh) = drink **sv** (sah) = I

bunna (bahn-na) = want/ need
