Adjective: balama achukma – fragrant/ having a good odor/ smells good

Im ilefoka yvt balama achukma.

Her clothes smell good.

Na pakanli ilvppvt balama achukma fehna.

This flower is very fragrant.

Word Meaning:

im (ehm) = his, hers, its

ilefoka (e-lee-foh-ka)

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

fehna (feh-na) = very

ilvppvt (ih-lahp-paht) = subject marker (this)

balama achukma (bah-la-mah ah-chohk-ma) =
fragrant/having a good odor/ smells good

na pakanli (na pah-kahn-li) = flower
