Location/ Position: hikia – to be standing (singular)

Chim abinili yvt kocha hikia.

Your chair is standing outside.

Ohoyo yvt katimma hikia?

Where is the woman standing?

Word Meaning: **chim** (chim) = your

abinili (ah-bi-ni-li) = chair **yvt** (yaht) = subject marker

kocha (koh-cha) = outside

hikia (hik-^{eh}n-yah) = to be standing

ohoyo (o-ho-yo) = woman

katimma (kah-tim-ma) = where
