

# Lesson of The Day

Object Marker: *yumma* – that/ those

**Ofi chito yumma ipeta li tuk.**

I fed that big dog.

**Shupo tuklo yumma su bunnna.**

(When the subject is accompanied by a number it is plural and thus, ‘yumma’ will translate as ‘those’.)

I want those two hats.

Word Meaning: **tuk** (tohk) = past tense

**ofi** (o-fe) = dog

**shupo** (shah-poh) = hat

**su** (sah) = I

**chito** (che-toh) = big/large

**yumma** (yahm-mah) = that/those

**li** (le) = I

**ipeta** (e-pe-tah) = feed

**tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

**bunnna** (bahn-nah) = want
