Possessive Pronouns: A and um – my

a = nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a *consonant*

um = m form, prefixed before words that begin with a *vowel*

**A nakfi yut chaha.**

My brother is tall.

**A nakfi yut towa washoha.**

My brother plays ball.

**Word Meaning:** **a** (anh) = my

**nakfi** (nahk-fe) = brother      **yut** (yaht) = subject marker

**chaha** (cha-ha) = tall      **towa** (to-wa) = ball

**washoha** (wa-sho-ha) = plays
