

Lesson of The Day

Katimikma – when (in the future)

kma is siffixed to words that mark time

Katimikma aiittvnaha ish ia chi?

When will you go to church?

Katimikma holisso apisa ia la chi?

When will I go to school?

Word Meaning: **katimikma** (kah-te-mek-ma) = when

aiittvnaha (eye-eh-ta-na-ha) = church **ish** (esh) = you

ia (e-ya) = to go **achi** (ah-ch^{enh}) = future tense

holisso apisa (hoh-lis-so ah-pi-sah) = school **li** (le) = I

*Note: ‘**li**’ changes to ‘**la**’ to accommodate for ‘**achi**’
